Investment Objective:

Seeks to provide a high level of income and preservation of capital.

Investment Strategy:

The fund seeks to achieve its investment objective by investing, in general, in a mix of collective trusts managed by Transamerica Asset Management, Inc. ("TAM") or by Aegon USA Investment Management LLC ("AUIM"), mutual funds managed by TAM, and a group annuity contract issued by and supported by the Transamerica Life Insurance Company ("TLIC") general account ("Stable Value Option") (collectively, "Underlying Investments"). TAM, AUIM and TLIC are affiliated with the Trustee. During normal market conditions, the fund invests approximately 10% of its assets in stock funds, 64.8% in bond funds, 25% in the Stable Value Option and 0.2% in Money Market funds.

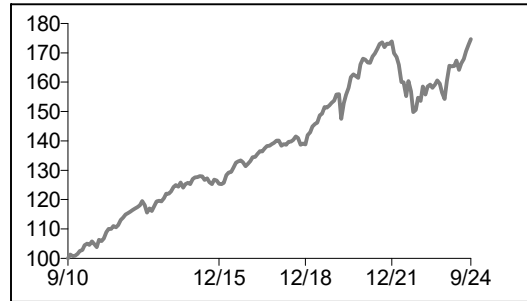

The collective trust fund ("CTF") is offered through the Transamerica Asset Management, Inc. Collective Investment Trust (the "Trust"), which is sponsored by Transamerica Trust Company ("TTC"), the Trustee of the Trust. The CTF invests a portion of its assets in a Transamerica general account stable value product ("Stable Value Option"). The Stable Value Option is a group annuity contract issued by Transamerica Life Insurance Company ("TLIC"). Transamerica earns income indirectly by including Stable Value in the CTF. The CTF also invests in underlying funds managed by TAM and AUIM, affiliates of TTC, and from which TTC and/or an affiliate receives revenue. The CTF is not a mutual fund and is exempt from registration, therefore, a prospectus is not available. The CTF is not insured by the FDIC, Federal Reserve Bank, nor guaranteed by TTC or any affiliate. TAM, AUIM TLIC and TTC are indirect affiliates of Aegon.
